# Bibbulmun Track DIVERSION

This prescribed burn is proposed for sometime during

This diversion will be installed immediately prior to the burn commencing and will be removed as soon as possible after the completion of the burn.



## PRESCRIBED BURN

**North Donnelly State Forest**

The Bibbulmun Track is closed for 12.1km due to prescribed burning.

A 11.3km diversion is in place along sections of Gold Gully, Stallard, Boundary and Sears Road.

Willow Springs Campsite will remain open.

The original route will remain closed until declared safe.

For your safety **DO NOT** enter any closed trail, even if there are no indications of prescribed burning activity. Stay on the marked diversion and follow all signage or instructions from Parks and Wildlife staff.

Walkers should be aware of fire operations vehicles and other traffic in the area.
