The Munda Biddi Trail is closed for 8km due to prescribed burning.

A 9km diversion along Dale and Ashendon Roads and Brookton Highway is in place.

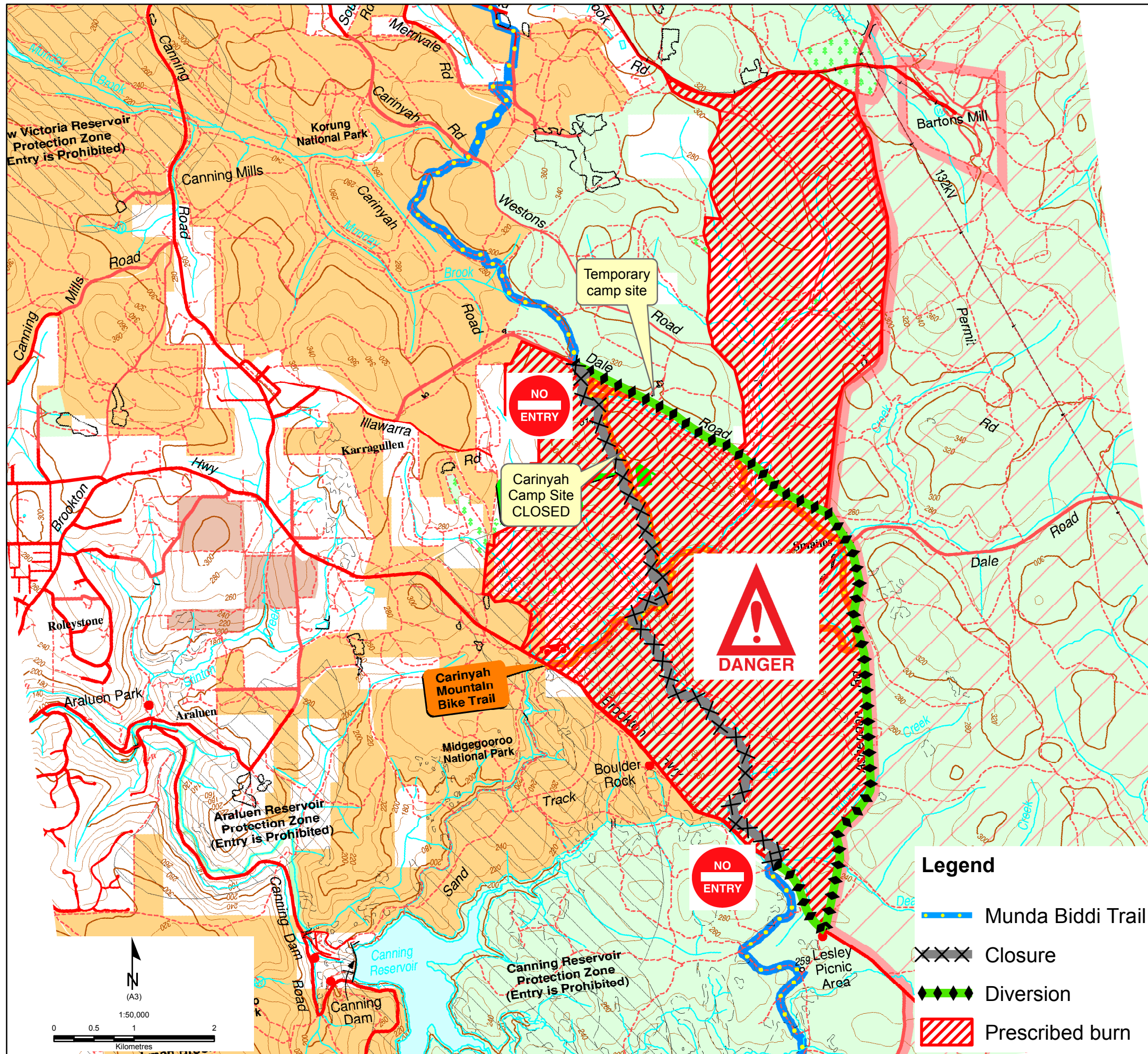
The original route will remain closed until declared safe.

For your safety stay on the marked diversion, adhere to and follow all signage and instructions from Parks and Wildlife and other emergency staff.

Riders should note that Carinyah Camp Site is CLOSED. A temporary camp site is available. Water will be provided. All water should be treated prior to consumption. There is no toilet. Riders should follow Leave No Trace principles and bury all human waste at least 15cm deep and at least 100m from water and the trail. There is no shelter. Riders **MUST** provide their own tent.

Riders should be aware of fire operations vehicles and other traffic in the area.
