The Bibbulmun Track is closed for 51.8km due to prescribed burning.

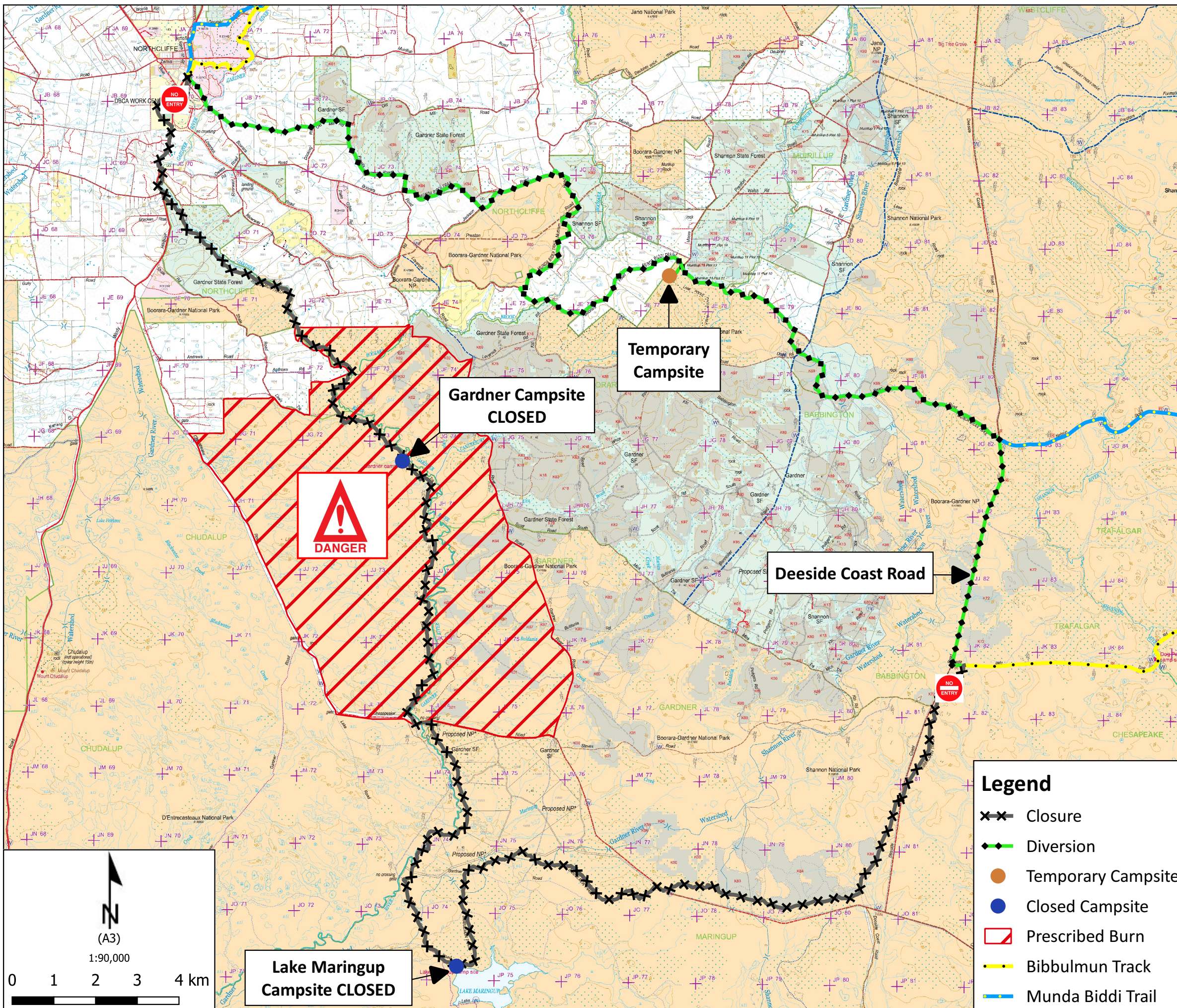
A 37.2km diversion is in place along the Munda Biddi Trail and Deeside Coast Road.

Gardner and Lake Maringup Campsites are closed. A temporary campsite is in place at Boorara Tree with potable water and toilets.

For your safety **DO NOT** enter any closed trail, even if there are no indications of prescribed burning activity. Stay on the marked diversion and follow all signage or instructions from Parks and Wildlife staff.

Walkers should be aware of fire operation vehicles and other traffic in the area.
